NER TAMID Jessica and Eric Zachs

Believing that "the centralities of being Jewish are the lessons of Torah, the importance of the State of Israel, and their connection to living your life," Jessica and Eric Zachs live these values and ideals through their personal actions, the examples they set for their children, and their commitment to the wider community in which they live. Their generous support of the entire Jewish Community and its member agencies are true examples of Tikkun Olam.

Jessica and Eric have been active at Solomon Schechter Day School since 1993 when Benjamin entered kindergarten. Jacob and Zoë also joined Schechter when they were in kindergarten. Both Jessica and Eric have served on the Schechter Board; Jessica was a vice-president and this June she will be completing her term as Co-President, which she began in 2015.

Jessica and Eric's volunteer efforts extend beyond Schechter. They have both served on the Greater Hartford Jewish Federation Board, assuming active fundraising and community awareness roles. Jessica served on the Jewish Community Foundation of Greater Hartford Board and remains on the Grants Committee. She served two terms on the Connecticut Children's Medical Center Foundation Board and is a class officer for Cornell University. Nationally, she was a member of the National Young Leadership Cabinet where she was Campaign Co-Chair in 2001. Currently, she is on the National Women's Philanthropy Board and Co-Chair of Recruitment and Engagement for the 2019 International Lion of Judah

Conference. Eric has given his time to many Jewish and community non-profits. He was President of the Mandell Jewish Community Center and Hartford County Chair of the ADL and served on the Community Capital Campaign Executive Committee. Most recently, he was Campaign Chair of the Greater Hartford Jewish Federation before becoming Chair and now serves as Chair Emeritus. Eric served as cochair of the Aim Chai Endowment Campaign, which raised over \$40 million for community agencies. He is currently on the Board of the Hartford Dispensary which treats 6000 opiate addicts per month and is on the Hartford Regional Board of Hartford Healthcare. Previously, he served on the boards of of Saint Francis Hospital Foundation, Hartford Hospital and the University of Connecticut Foundation.

In 2006, along with Eric's parents, the Zachs family was honored with the ADL's "Torch of Liberty Award," recognizing families and individuals for their philanthropic works and the humanitarian values passed from one generation to the next.

Jessica and Eric have traveled to Israel many times; they just returned last week. Eric's first trip was in the summer of 1977, when he spent the summer working at Kibbutz Bet Keshet. Jessica's first trip was with Eric and other participants of Dor L'Dor (From Generation to Generation), a Federation-sponsored program. Over the years, they have participated in and chaired various Federation missions. Jessica participated in the Hazon Bike Ride. More than once they have shared unforgettable trips to Israel with their children.

When Benjamin was in eighth grade at Schechter, Jessica and Eric generously established a fund to ensure all classmates would be able to travel together to Israel. Due to the political situation at the time, the trip was cancelled but the fund remained with the school to benefit future students.

Jessica and Eric have passed their passion of helping others onto their children. Benjamin is currently a member of the Schechter Board of Trustees; he co-chaired the search committee that brought Andrea Kasper to the school. While in college, he was the Movember Big Man on Campus, raising the most money nationwide for men's cancer awareness. After graduation, Ben worked for Teach for America and served on the Action Academy Board, crafting the application for a new Philadelphia charter school. He has also worked at Pearson Publishing and Bridgewater Associates. Ben and Paige married in 2015. Upon graduation from college, Paige was a Strategy and Senior Associate at PricewaterhouseCoopers. Until recently, Paige was the Operations Strategy Manager for Warby Parker. Paige volunteers with Minds Matter NYC, providing personal coaching, mentoring, and college preparatory assistance to high school students from low-income families.

During college, Jacob interned for George Stephanopoulos and various senators and congressmen on Capitol Hill. While in college he was on the board of GW Acting Politically for Israel. After graduation, he worked on Corey Booker's Senate

Campaign. Currently, he is Senior Sales Executive for Newsela, an educational technology firm promoting literacy in grades 2-12 and community colleges through use of non-fiction. Jacob spent a summer abroad with Alexander Muss Summer Program in Israel and will be participating on Birthright this summer.

While in college, Zoë participated in fundraising for Saint Jude's Children's Research Hospital. She spent her semester abroad at Tel Aviv University. Two years ago, Zoë graduated with a Master's Degree in Social Work from Columbia University. As a LMSW, Zoë began her career at a residential treatment facility in the Bronx for children with severe behavioral and psychological disorders. She is now a therapist at a Mount Sinai School-Based Health Center in East Harlem.

Jessica and Eric are extremely proud of their four children and all their accomplishments.




