| Isopropyl Alcohol | May be used topically as an autiseplic for skin care |
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| Lye Irrigating Solution | May be used to flush eyes and for self-cleaning of <br> contacts |
| Mouth Rinse | May be used to rinse or freshen mouth |
| Iodized Salt | May be used to gargle for throat discomfort. |
| Acetaminophen | Used only with signed parent permission |$|$| Ibuprofen | Used only with signed parent permission |
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| Saline Wound Wash be used to clean wounds of dirt and debris |  |
| Bactine Liquid Antiseptic/Pain <br> Reliever | May be used topically for prevention of infection and <br> relief of pain and ithing from minor cuts, scrapes and <br> burns. For students over 2 years of age. |
| Petroleum Jelly | May be used for chapped lips. |
| Dental Wax | May be used with orthodontic appliances to <br> protect against mouth sores |
| lemollient, fragrance-free such <br> as Lubriderm, Eucerin, <br> Cetophil Lotion or generic <br> equivalent. | May be used for dry, irritated skin. <br> Hand Sanitizer |


| Bacitracin Antibiotic <br> Ointment or Petroleum. Jelly | May be used topically for minor abrasions and <br> lacerations. |
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| Caladryl | May be used topically for itching from insect bites <br> or rash for students over 2 years of age. May cause <br> skin irritation. |
| Hydrocotisone Cream 1\% | May be used topically for itching from insect bites <br> or rash |
| Tums | May be used for upset stomach for student over <br> 12 years of age. |
