## ***Shana Tovah Cards!***

Do you get tired of hand-writing your New Year's cards and worry about getting them sent out in time? We have a solution for you! Let the SSDS PTO do the work for you.

If you didn't participate last year, it works much like our very popular Mishloach Manot program; you will be able to send your New Year's greetings to Jewish families at SSDS and across the country! In just a few weeks, you will receive a user name and password. Then, you can log in to [www.shanatovahproject.com](http://www.shanatovahproject.com) and check off the names of people you'd like to receive a Shana Tovah greeting from you and your family. At Rosh Hashanah, all the members of the SSDS community will receive a card and a list of greetings sent from all the different families will appear with the card. The list of fees appears below.

If you would like to send a New Year's greeting to families who are not already on our list, you can do that also. You can enter a list of names and addresses, and the SSDS PTO will label and send the card for you! No more messing with stamps and return address labels!

If you would like to send out your cards yourself, you will be able to purchase packs of the Shana Tovah cards for \$18 for a package of 10 cards.
