Collaboration with Art and Humanities is Going Strong!

As part of their Black History Month studies with the Middle School, Mrs. Simon and Ms. Van are demonstrating the power of collaboration and cooperation as they discuss, analyze and create using poetry and visual art. Mrs. Simon introduced the poem <u>"I, Too.."</u> by Langston Hughes and Ms. Van set up a gallery of Titus Kaphar's <u>work</u>. The students analyzed the images, selecting and explaining why certain images that "spoke" to them; they broke apart the poem (individually and in small groups), and then the students choose a line from the poem to attach to one of Titus' works. "I was blown away at how engaged the students were and how they



jumped into making connections between the written art and visual art forms!" described Ms. Van.

The next step for the students will be creating a small work inspired by a classic image, abstracted to tell another side of the story.
