Exploring Electricity in MakerSpace

Schechter students are exploring the exciting world of electricity through Snap Circuits, an educational resource designed to teach concepts of circuitry. With the careful



instruction of Mandy Fontaine, students have been tackling various projects including creating electric light bulbs and developing more advanced sound machines and electrical motors. Students have also been encouraged to create their own circuits using the skills that they have learned throughout the class.

Catch the Latest News in PE

In Physical Education, students are working on catching, throwing and retrieving balls in developmentally appropriate activities. The EC and Parparim students are thoroughly enjoying an activity where all the balls (we call them "insects") are thrown around the gym and the students run around to bring all the "insects" back to their home. Students are able to run, retrieve, and work together to bring the insects home. Rimonim, Gesher and The Middle School have used tennis balls individually and with partners to improve hand-eye coordination, catching and throwing as well as playing team handball. Handball helps further develop



hand-eye coordination as well as teamwork. All students will experiment with scoops and balls (modified Jai-Alai) to continue strengthening hand-eye coordination. K-8 students are also learning their Israeli dance routines to prepare for the Israeli Dance Festival on February 12. Mark your calendars!
