# Dear Parents,

Attached is the supply list for the school year 2020-2021. This list is longer than usual because as a faculty we will be adhering to all COVID-19 instructions. One import change is students will no longer be allowed to share their supplies, hence the longer list. We also built in the possibility that we may need to revert quickly to distance learning, so we recommend that you have a set of the highlighted supplies at home.

# General items:

- 8 easily distinguishable 2 pocket folders to organize their papers according to subject (2 for Humanities, 1 for Judaic Studies, 2 for Hebrew, Spanish, Math, Science (students may not use their Chromebook case as a holder for their folders)
- 2 packages #2 pencils
- 1 zippered pencil pouch
- 1 package pencil erasers
- 4 kippot **labeled** with the student's name (for boys, optional for girls); 3 of the kippot will be stored in a ziploc bag.
- Individual tissues students can use.
- Earbuds that are compatible for Chromebook
- 5 clean masks labeled with the student's name. Must be brought home daily to be cleaned.
- Paper bags for storing masks when necessary
- Small bottle of liquid soap
- Small bottle of hand sanitizer 60% alcohol
- Plastic Clipboards
- 2 glue sticks
- Box of color pencils or thin tipped markers
- Pencil sharpener
- Lined paper
- 2-3 containers Sanitizing Wipes
- Water bottle with closing lid (Note: water bottles will be refilled from the classroom sink)
- Scissors
- 2-3 pens
- Ruler with inches and centimeters
- A portable container which can be easily sanitized (about the size of a milk crate) which will hold all of each student's supplies, chromebooks, and books. This crate will remain in school. Examples are at the end of this list
- A similar container to be kept at home to keep student's supplies organized
- 2 packages chisel tip dry erase markers assorted colors
- 4 highlighters different colors
- 2 packages 3x5 index cards

### Math

- TI30XS (Texas Instrument) calculator. It is recommended that students have a second calculator at home as their calculator will remain in school.
- 2 graph ruled 4x4 spiral notebooks- can be found at Staples (no hard bound notebooks please and nothing smaller than 4 squares per inch)
- 1 book cover for textbook

- Calculator (if they have a second calculator)
- Graph paper for home

• A composition notebook

### Hebrew

- 2 composition notebooks
- 1 1/2 inch binder

### Humanities

• Post-it 3 x 3 inches notes, 8 pads/pack (neon or multicolor if possible)

• Incoming Grade 6 Students will be purchasing their own chromebooks through the school.

# Art- These items will give the ability to do art fully at home if distance learning occurs, as well as maintain proper social distance guidelines in class. (Supplies will also be provided by SSDS art studio in addition to the supplies below)

- 2 Bristol Paper Pads: 9"x12" or 11"x 14" (one for school/one for home)
- Watercolor palette (solid/cakes preferred-Prismacolor or Arteza are good brands)
- MultiColor pack of Sharpies
- Tempera or Acrylic Paints (small beginner pack of tubes is great)
- Drawing pencils: 8B-6H
- Brushes: multi-pack
- Option to purchase multipack of supplies <u>HERE option 1</u>, <u>option 2</u>, <u>option 3</u>

- Sketch Pad
- Modeling <u>Clay</u> (1-2lbs)
- Large <u>clipboard</u> preferred, but standard size is acceptable (please note clipboard is part of general supplies. Only purchase if you are buying the larger size in addition to the standard size).

# **Examples of supply containers:**

The crate/container should be about 15" w x 15:d x 13"h and will be transported by the student from class to class. It will need to be large enough to carry their supplies, but not so large that your child cannot carry it. Backpacks can be used to bring items home, but backpacks will not be allowed in the classrooms. Please note these are just ideas and are not exact models of what you need to purchase. Please choose what will work best for your child.

- The EZ Crate is a durable, high capacity rolling crate with a built-in handle that folds flat for easy storage. The EZ Crate features a 15"w x 15"d x 13"h basket, lightweight durable plastic construction, 2 non marring casters, extendable easy grip aluminum handle and a weight of only 8lbs.
