

Aftercare Coordinator

The Solomon Schechter Day School of Greater Hartford is seeking a highly responsible, reliable, warm Aftercare Coordinator to join our team. Schechter is a warm, progressive, exciting Jewish day school for 2-year-olds through 8th graders. Our Aftercare program, which we call "Tzaharon", welcomes approximately 14 children from age 2 through 4th grade each day. We are seeking someone who can get down on the floor to play with children — and communicate professionally with their parents; someone who wants to work directly with the children, but also be responsible for other aftercare staff and for parent communication.

Responsibilities of this part-time position (typically 14-16 hours per week) include basic planning; helping students get organized; setting them up with a snack, playing and reading to them; calming them down and redirecting them when necessary; arranging for appropriate coverage if another staff member is absent; communicating with parents at pick-up.

Aftercare begins at 3:15 p.m. each day (2:15 p.m. on Wednesdays and most Fridays), and ends when the last child is picked up, no later than 6 p.m. (3:30 p.m. on Fridays during the late fall, winter, and early spring).

Qualifications:

- Strong organizational skills
- Experience working with children
- Classroom experience (early childhood or elementary school) as a teacher, aide or assistant is a plus
