Shorashim Sees the World Through Patterns

If you have had a chance to visit the multi-age Shorashim class recently (Early Childhood 3 and 4), you may have heard the children enthusiastically calling out, "green-blue-green-blue" or "stick-rock-jewel-stick-rock-jewel!" Patterns spark authentic learning, as patterns exist all around us! Patterns

are arrangements of things that repeat in a logical way. They allow us to see relationships and develop generalizations. The arrangement of colors, shapes, gestures, sounds, images, and numbers is an important concept for young children and contributes to their early math understanding. The children thrive, working collaboratively in multi-age groups, supporting one another to recognize and create patterns.
