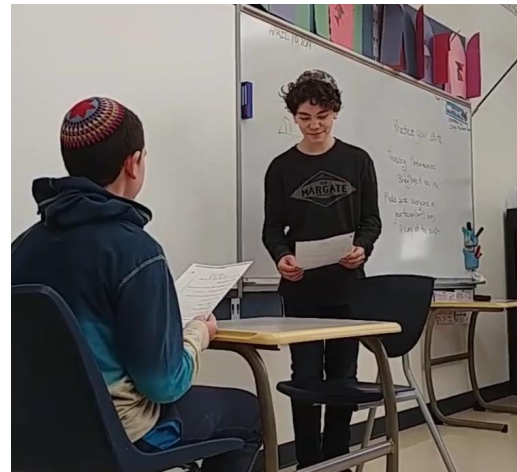
Middle school students use humor in Hebrew, Gesher creates majestic Yads, and Seder preparations in Parparim
