Gesher's First Torah Readings

The Rimonim Bridge Challenge!

CRASH! SPLASH! and the sounds of children cheering... just some things you might have heard coming from the Rimonim classroom last Monday. Over the past two weeks, the students have been testing the strength of their bridges as the culmination of their Architecture

unit. In this unit, students studied structures from around the world to understand concepts of form vs. function, trusses, the physics of triangles, and also fictional literature. Before construction began, students created blueprints of their bridges. Once blueprints were approved by the teacher, they could purchase "timber" - jumbo and regular size popsicle sticks - for different prices. The goal was to create a bridge that is 15 inches long and can withstand the weight of an attached bucket, filled with water. The bridges were judged to determine the strongest bridge, cheapest bridge, and by student vote, the most attractive bridge.

The students showed up to demolition day with their best work. Various structures, techniques, and



trusses were on display. Bridges broke, popsicle sticks went flying, water was everywhere. One unexpected outcome is that four different bridges (built by Lazer, Jonathan, Micah, and Evan) did not break under the weight of THREE completely filled buckets! In the days to come, we will find other ways to break these unbreakable bridges and officially determine which bridge was strongest! The **Dubonim** class had a fun-filled learning experience at Westmoor Park. Jennifer, the naturalist, taught the students about many of the animals. Favorite activities included feeding the goat, petting the baby chicken with fancy feet, petting the soft white bunny, seeing the big horses and cows, and seeing the newborn goats! Meanwhile, **Shorashim** Visited Auerfarm to learn about how farms produce food. The children dug in the garden to find worms, planted seeds, learned about the parts of a plant and searched for signs of Spring at the farm.
